Workshop Objective:

The objective of this Midwest/Great Plains regional workshop, to be held in Omaha, Nebraska, is to understand the reasons and purpose surrounding the paradigm shift in State decision making for implementing accelerated bridge construction as common practice in bridge project delivery and to assist contractors and suppliers in partnering in this effort. It focuses on explaining the need for ABC and developing a path forward to support contractor buy-in.

Background:

Between August and October of 2019, an interview survey was conducted by Atorod Azizinamini, ABC-UTC Director, with more than 30 State Bridge Engineers. Each State was interviewed for about one hour, asking them the topics that need to be researched or issues that would help to further advance ABC. Survey results indicated that the number one issue for States to promote ABC is the buy-in of contractors.
