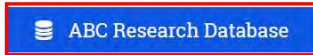

The **Research Database** is fully functioning. The research is currently being populated to match the TRB ABC Subcommittee's research tracking spreadsheet, *Project Tracker*.

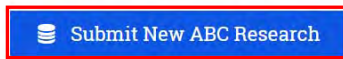
Access to the Research Database

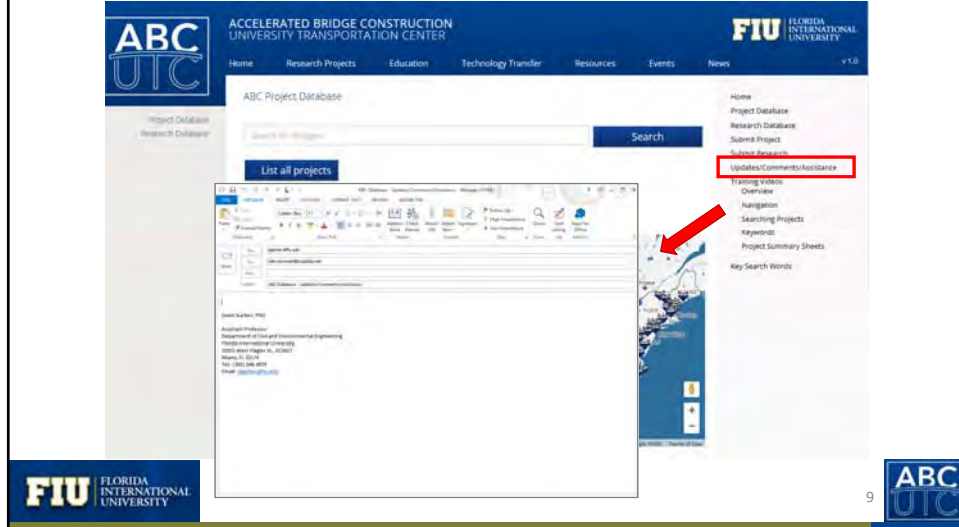
